### **PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS**

This Enteki Taikai is an individual competition, each country may send 6 archers maximum.

The Taikai is open to all grades from Shodan upward.

The minimum age is 16 years with no upper age limit.

The event is open to both men and women.

### **TAIKAI GUIDELINES**

The overall rules governing this tournament are the ANKF Rules of Competition (June 1991) with the guidelines based on these rules:

- The competition will be held in standing form – Rissha.
- Scoring for the competitions will use the accuracy system (Tekichusei) decision based on the number of hits. Order of shooting will use competition timing.
- According to the number of participants changes might be possible and will be announced beforehand.
- Three archers will share one target.
- Distance: 60 m; Target: 100 cm ANKF Kasumi Enteki Mato.
- In case of a tie break the Izume method is used to decide the winner.
- Rounds for the competition will be 3 x 4 (Yotsuya) plus the tie break.

### **AWARDS**

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places will receive an award certificate and an honour gift.

### **EQUIPMENT and CLOTHING**

Equipment must follow the accepted requirement (§23) ANKF Rules of Competition. Please note that Enteki arrows are requested. (Points are sharp, not nipple type. Feathers are smaller than the flights of Matoya). If you join in only the seminar on Saturday, normal Matoya will be accepted.

Clothing must follow the requirement (§24) ANKF Rules of Competition.

### **ACCOMMODATION and MEALS**

Participants, judges and assistants have to take care about the accommodation by their own.

1. The cheapest way is to sleep in the Dojo in your own sleeping bag. Showers and breakfast are available. Price per person and night: 5 Euro, payable at the registration. Private accommodations available on request.

### **PARTICIPATION FEES**

Participants for the seminar and TAIKAI pay a fee of 20 Euro.  
Participants who will attend only the seminar pay a fee of 15 Euro  
Participants can pay their fees at the venue.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

The chairman of the national federation must inform the organisation chairman of the hosting country (DkyuB) about the number of participants he/she wish to send, by completing the application form below, and returning it to him by the 6<sup>th</sup> September 2009 at the latest.

The names of the participants could be send together with the application form but the final listing will be made during the registration at the TAIKAI venue.
